Ship or deliver one pint of your syrup to the Phelps Chamber of Commerce prior to Maple Syrup Fest or to the judges' table at Maple Syrup Fest by 9:30am on April 6th. Maple Syrup Fest will be at Phelps School, 4451 Old School Road, Phelps, WI. Results will be announced at the Fest before 3pm and also emailed to all who entered within ONE WEEK after. Winners in each category and overall winner receive an award ribbon.

Phelps Maple Syrup Fest

2024 Maple Syrup Judging Contest Rules



- 1. Entrants need not be present to win.
- 2. Entrants must fill out a registration form and submit with entry fee by **April 6, 2024**. Syrup may be shipped or delivered and must be received on or before 9:30 A.M. the day of the event.
- 3. There is a \$10 entry fee.
- 4. Entries become the property of Phelps Maple Syrup Fest.
- 5. Entry must consist of one U.S. pint of Pure Maple Syrup.
- 6. Only one entry per person or sugarbush.
- 7. There should be a label or sticker on the bottle stating sugarbush name and address. To comply with WDATCP rules, your label should also include:
 - Name
 - Address, city and state
 - The entries are 1 pint, so the label must read: 16 fl. oz (473ml). This should be on the lower third of the label.
 - Front panel must say Pure Maple Syrup in upper half of label.
 - Front panel should also include the grade of the syrup.
 - In addition to the label, the bottle should have a safety seal or neck band.
- 8. Entries will be placed in uniform glass containers with sticker entry numbers. The only link between entrant and entry is that number. The purpose is to keep entries anonymous to the tasting judges for a blind taste test.
- 9. Winners will be based on a final score of all categories. Categories will consist of the Density, Clarity, Flavor, Color, and Container/Label.
- 10. Winners receive award ribbons, no cash prizes.
